resistance to western oppression against indigenous nations contemporary native religious practices and native intellectual challenges to academia essays address indigenous perspectives on topics usually treated by non indians such as role of women in indian society the importance of sacred sites to american indian religious identity and relationship of native language to indigenous autonomy a closing essay by deloria in vintage form reminds native americans of their responsibilities and obligations to one another and to past and future generations this book argues for renewed cultivation of a native american studies that is more indian centered
