kiyoko s intellectual world expanded through her involvement with christian organisations such as the ywca and the wscf and when she went to the united states as an exchange student and worked at wscf headquarters her involvement with the world council of churches also entailed extensive travel in asia as well as europe and much engaged discussion on the future of ecumenicism in the 1950s she contributed to unofficial diplomacy between japan and other asian nations and to restoring friendly relations and mutual understanding between japanese and other asian people including chinese filipino and indian
