based on the classic history of broadcasting in the united states tube of plenty represents the fruit of several decades labor when erik barnouw premier chronicler of american broadcasting and a participant in the industry for fifty years first undertook the project of recording its history many viewed it as a light weight literary task concerned mainly with entertainment trivia indeed trivia such as that found in quiz programs do appear in the book but barnouw views them as part of a complex social tapestry that increasingly defines our era to understand our century
