dieses buch stellt 21 forschungsarbeiten zur erforschung des sozialraums vor und beschäftigt sich im zuge dessen mit 1 dem theorie methoden verhältnis 2 der konkreten methodischen umsetzung eines forschungsprojektes und 3 den notwendigen reflexionen im hinblick auf das

geographische handeln denn geographisches denken und forschen ist durch paradigmata und methodenpluralismus geprägt beides befruchtet die geographie stellt studierende und doktorierende jedoch auch vor große herausforderungen da für die vielzahl von forschungsfragen nicht eine allgemeingültige theorie und generalisierende methode zur anwendung kommen kann fragen wie welche sozialräumlichen praktiken können mit welcher theorie und methode analysiert werden wie kann forschungslogik und gegenstandsangemessenheit gewährleistet werden und welche gütekriterien garantieren gute forschung sind fragen die innerhalb von forschungsprozessen immer wieder aufkommen die beiträge geben forschungspraktische antworten und motivieren für einen kreativen transparenten und nachvollziehbaren forschungsprozess

ausgehend von einem qualitativ längsschnittlich und konstruktivistischen forschungsdesign untersucht die vorliegende studie das erleben von entscheidungsprozessen am inklusiv verstandenen Übergang von sekundarstufe i in weitere schulische bildung aus sicht von jugendlichen mit behinderung und eltern mit ohne behinderung im mittelpunkt stehen die erzählungen von 5 familien 3 jugendliche mit behinderung 3 väter 5 mütter mit ohne behinderung die im Übergangs entscheidungsprozess drei mal im abstand von einem jahr mittels intensiv interviewing charmaz 2014 befragt wurden zur auswertung des qualitativen datenmaterials 32 interviews wurde auf die kodierschritte von charmaz 2014 zurückgegriffen die datenanalyse offenbart drei varianten des entscheidens entscheiden abgeben entscheiden forcieren entscheiden müssen als ausdifferenzierungen der übergeordneten entscheidungsformen selbstständig entscheiden und unterstützend selbstständig entscheiden zentral ist die erwartung eines selbstständigen entscheidungssubjekts an der sich die jugendlichen mit behinderung und eltern orientieren damit einher gehen unterschiedliche varianten des wollens wenn jugendliche mit behinderung als entscheidungssubjekte selbstständig es wirklich wollen mit unterstützung es nicht wollen oder innerhalb vorselektierter optionen es müssen eine wahl treffen durch das längsschnittliche forschungsdesign können zudem die bildungsverläufe der jugendlichen mit behinderung nachgezeichnet werden

experiencing nature has positive effects on mental development health and well being and can be interpreted as an element of a good life this book relates this connection to learning and educational settings educational processes in biology education are defined not only by the acquisition of relevant subject matter but also about the encounter confrontation and transformation of the self the central assumptions of this book are firstly that the latter can be facilitated through nature experiences and secondly that this can also positively influence subject specific learning processes

this book shares with an international audience of teachers scholars and policymakers the experience of pedagogical practices to facilitate sustainability in the world sustainability is seen here as a journey toward the end state of sustainable development therefore the authors contribute different roads to engage teachers and students with pedagogical discourse overall the book demonstrates the value of powerful

knowledge through action oriented learning based on a bottom up process consequently pedagogical practices are understood as the instructional approaches based on a social constructivist model in which active learning is performed with student to student engagement secondary teachers in social sciences and university professors in geography find the study to be a valuable source of stimulation for incorporating new ideas and resolving common problems in their learning and teaching environments education policymakers around the world also benefit from the only publication that presents international perspectives on geographical knowledge related to sustainability the contributing authors are experienced scientists in the field of geography education who are giving special attention to pedagogical practices that promote new directions toward sustainable thinking this book is the first outcome of an international collaboration officially established in 2023 between the department of geography and environmental studies at texas state university and the department of geography at the university of bayreuth
