intelligence and security services it should aim to make the intelligence and security committee a proper parliamentary select committee with independent advice and reporting to parliament not the prime minister it should publish all versions of guidance given to intelligence and security service personnel about detaining and interviewing individuals overseas and make public all relevant legal opinions provided to ministers there should be an independent inquiry into the allegations
