by the time pearl harbour had ripped apart america's peacetime pretensions the german blitzkrieg had already blasted the red army back to the gates of moscow yet less than four years later the soviet hammer and sickle flew above the ruins of berlin stark symbol of a miraculous comeback that destroyed the german army and shattered hitler's imperial designs

by spring 1942 hitler's forces on the eastern front were suffering heavy losses to replace these casualties the army requested the transfer of 20 000 men from the kriegsmarine and 200 000 airmen from the luftwaffe to be retrained as infantry reichsmarschall hermann göring head of the luftwaffe vehemently opposed the plan fearing it would diminish his political power after several luftwaffe failures he proposed instead that the luftwaffe raise and equip these 200 000 men arguing their nazi spirit would benefit the war effort hitler prioritizing political loyalty over military logic approved the creation of luftwaffen felddivisionen luftwaffe field divisions despite being ill suited for front line combat these divisions were deployed in all theatres except north africa they were generally ineffective with many regarded as fit only for garrison duties on the eastern front they struggled due to the brutal intensity of the fighting however two divisions the 12th and 21st performed relatively well this in depth study examines the luftwaffe field divisions uncovering the tragic consequences of göring's decision many luftwaffe personnel perished in these ill prepared divisions whose lives might have been spared had they received proper army training the research draws on extensive archival materials highlighting the human cost of this strategic blunder

on the murderous road to racial purity hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding jewish identity after centuries of jewish assimilation and intermarriage in german society he discovered that eliminating jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he d anticipated as bryan rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the german military contrary to conventional views rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of german military men were classified by the nazis as jews or partial jews mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals as rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived german nation in turn they had been embraced by the wehrmacht which prior to hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers the process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of nazi law numerous exemptions were

made in order to allow a soldier to stay within the ranks or to spare a soldier's parent spouse or other relative from incarceration or far worse Hitler's own signature can be found on many of these exemption orders but as the war dragged on Nazi politics came to trump military logic even in the face of the Wehrmacht's growing manpower needs closing legal loopholes and making it virtually impossible for these soldiers to escape the fate of millions of other victims of the Third Reich based on a deep and wide ranging research in archival and secondary sources as well as extensive interviews with more than four hundred Mischlinge and their relatives Rigg's study breaks truly new ground in a crowded field and shows from yet another angle the extremely flawed dishonest demeaning and tragic essence of Hitler's rule

it seemed that whenever Mussolini acted on his own it was bad news for Hitler indeed the Führer's relations with his Axis partners were fraught with an almost total lack of coordination compared to the Allies the coalition was hardly an alliance at all focusing on Germany's military relations with Italy Romania Hungary and Finland Richard Dinardo unearths a wealth of information that reveals how the Axis coalition largely undermined Hitler's objectives from the eastern front to the Balkans Mediterranean and North Africa Dinardo argues that the Axis military alliance was doomed from the beginning by a lack of common war aims the absence of a unified command structure and each nation's fundamental mistrust of the others Germany was disinclined to make the kinds of compromises that successful wartime partnerships demanded and because Hitler insisted on separate pacts with each nation Italy and Finland often found themselves conducting counterproductive parallel wars on their own Dinardo's detailed assessments of ground naval and air operations reveal precisely why the Axis allies were so dysfunctional as a collective force sometimes for seemingly mundane but vital reasons a shortage of interpreters for example his analysis covers coalition warfare at every level demonstrating that some military services were better at working with their allies than others while also pointing to rare successes such as Rommel's effective coordination with Italian forces in North Africa in the end while some individual Axis units fought with distinction if not on a par with the vaunted Wehrmacht and helped Germany achieve some of

experiences from the unique perspective of a doctor who often had to join in the fighting himself and witnessed the physical and psychological toll of combat

the battle of kursk was one of the defining moments of world war ii in july 1943 german forces under erich von manstein one of germany s best generals launched a massive attack in an offensive code named citadel a week later the soviets counterattacked sparking a huge clash of tanks at prokhorovka the largest armor battle in history pitting more than 600 soviet tanks against some 300 german panzers though the germans gained a tactical victory destroying huge numbers of soviet tanks they failed to achieve their objectives and in the end the battle marked a turning point on the eastern front the red army gained the strategic initiative and would not lose it
