it is now highly controversial to claim that jesus christ was a black man although he was considered to be black in ancient times the controversy of the race of jesus christ and the ancient israelites and jews will be explored in this work

with the publication of his two early works black theology black power 1969 and a black theology of liberation 1970 james cone emerged as one of
