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all over the world families and communities are key providers of care and support this is particularly true in relation to

serious illnesses such as hiv and aids yet families and communities can also stigmatize their members leaving people to die in the most appalling conditions this book looks at the diversity of family and community responses to hiv and aids by examining contexts as diverse as nuclear extended and refugee family households and gay community networks and structures it offers important insight into the factors which lead to positive responses and those which trigger negative ones

the 18 research articles of this volume discuss the major themes that have emerged from mathematical and statistical research in the epidemiology of hiv the opening paper reviews important recent contributions five sections follow statistical methodology and forecasting infectivity and the hiv heterogeneity and hiv transmission dynamics social dynamics and aids and the immune system and the hiv in each leading experts in aids epidemiology present the recent results some address the role of variable infectivity heterogeneous mixing and long periods of infectiousness in the dynamics of hiv others concentrate on parameter estimation and short term forecasting the last section looks at the interaction between the hiv and the immune system

organ transplantation has over a period of a few decades evolved from a daring experimental medical procedure to a widely used health technology many lives have been saved the quality of life of many other persons has been immeasurably improved there is now an abundant literature on the medical aspects of transplantation an increasing number of books on the legal ethical aspects aspects with which who has been concerned since the world health assembly first took up the matter in 1986 this book is the first global collection of laws regulations dealing with organ transplantation also included are the texts of some of the key international european declarations statements on the subject most of the materials that appear in the book were originally published in the who s international digest of health legislation but have never been collected in one volume before this book will be useful to parliamentarians health policy makers surgeons other health professionals involved in transplantation transplant coordinators ethicists others interested in in depth information on how different governments institutions have responded to the considerable ethical legal policy challenges posed by this important branch of curative medicine

this study looks at the global plague which is threatening to engulf south africa at a crucial moment in its history economists demographers and health planners present a range of new methods of understanding the likely course of the disease drawn from the most recent research

although efforts have been made and continue to be made to reduce the rate of hiv transmission in the u s and globally the rates continue to increase in the majority of countries in the u s members of minority communities remain especially at risk of hiv transmission an individual s discovery that he or she has contracted hiv or that a loved one has contracted the illness often raises significant issues that necessitate interaction with mental health professionals mental health practitioner s guide to hiv aids serves as a quick desk reference for professionals who may be less familiar with the terminology used in hiv aids care and services

religious institutions shaped the ways individuals communities and societies responded to hiv and aids since the 1980s this book draws on research studies ranging in context from sites in sub saharan africa to new york city in the usa to examine the complexity of responding to the epidemic both globally and locally religious systems of meaning practices and institutions have been central to the articulation of projects for social change and inversely sometime strongly resistant to change in diverse institutional responses to hiv and aids sometimes religious movements provided powerful forces for community mobilisation in response to the social vulnerability economic exclusion and health problems associated with hiv in other contexts religious cultures have reproduced values and practices that have seriously impeded more effective approaches to mitigate the epidemic by highlighting these complex and sometimes contradictory social processes this book provides new insights about the potential for religious institutions to address the hiv epidemic more effectively more broadly it shows how research can be done on religion in the area of global public health showing how civil society organizations shape opportunities for health promotion a crucial and new area of global public health research this book was originally published as a special issue of global public health

the education sector plays a key external role in preventing and reducing the stigma surrounding hiv aids it also plays an important internal role in providing access to care treatment and support for teachers and education staff a group that in many countries represents more than 60 percent of the public sector workforce the education sector can also have a critically important positive effect on the future even in the worst affected countries most schoolchildren are not infected for these children there is a chance to live lives free from aids if they can be educated on the knowledge and values that can protect them as they grow up the authors of accelerating the education sector response to hiv explore the experiences of education sectors across sub saharan africa as they scale up their responses to hiv aids within the accelerate initiative working group established in 2002 by the joint united nations programme on hiv aids unaids inter agency task team on education this book demonstrates that leadership by the ministries of education and commitment from key development partners are crucial for mobilizing activities and that full participation of all stakeholders is required for effective implementation this book summarizes the experiences of technical focal points from the 37 ministries of education in sub saharan africa which are represented on the sub regional networks for hiv and education these experiences prove that the education sector response can play a crucially important role in the multisectoral national responses to this epidemic

this salient text presents a culturally aware public health approach to the hiv epidemic in malaysia a country emblematic of

the muslim world's response to the crisis it explores complex interactions of religion with health as a source of coping as well as stigma and denial particularly as islam plays a central role in malaysian culture politics and policy at the heart of the book a groundbreaking study analyzes attitudes and behaviors toward prevention among diverse people living with hiv faith leaders and government health officials from these findings readers gain insight into how health professionals policymakers and organizations can create appropriate prevention programs in malaysia with implications for other muslim countries this timely volume situates malaysia and the asian pacific region in the context of the hiv epidemic analyzes ways islamic beliefs can shape perceptions of hiv and prevention policy reviews a unique study of stakeholder opinions and practices regarding hiv discusses the consequences of islamic rulings on sex outside marriage offers recommendations for effective hiv prevention practice and policy islam and health policies related to hiv prevention in malaysia is of immediate relevance to researchers studying hiv prevention social aspects of religion sexuality and sex education policymakers in health promotion and health education as well as graduate students in sex education sociology psychology and cultural studies should also find it useful

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coping with loss describes the many ways in which people cope with the death of someone they love most earlier books on bereavement have fallen into two categories distillations of the clinical experience of individual therapists or collections of chapters reporting the results of empirical studies each category is valuable but has tended to serve a narrow group of readers practitioners with particular theoretical orientations or researchers in quest of the latest findings coauthored by a leading research psychologist and an experienced therapist who specializes in bereavement education and intervention this book is different the authors weave together the strands of theory research and clinical wisdom into a seamless and readable narrative while they discuss previous work they also present new data never before published from one of the largest studies of bereaved people ever conducted the bereavement coping project unlike most studies to date which focused on only one type of bereaved group usually widows or widowers the bereavement coping project examined the experiences of several different groups during the first 18 months after the death the groups included those who had lost a spouse a parent an adult sibling or a child and those who had lost their significant other to cancer or cardiovascular disease on one hand as opposed to the stigmatized disease of aids on the other the book begins with a critical overview of theories of bereavement succeeding chapters explore in depth the impact of specific types of loss the impact of particular coping

strategies on recovery the impact of social supports and religion and the special cases of children and of people who seem to grow and change for the better after a loss a final chapter considers implications for intervention with bereaved people each chapter is richly illuminated with real life examples throughout and ends with a section called voices in which bereaved people describe their various attempts to cope in their own words insightful and informative

this book analyses the way that hiv aids is often narrativised and represented in contemporary world cultures as well as the different strategies of remembrance deployed by different sub cultural groups affected by the illness through a close study of a variety of cultural texts including cinema literature theatre art and photography amongst others it demonstrates the trajectory that such narratives and representations have undergone since the advent of the discovery of the disease in the 1980s acknowledging the central yet often overlooked role that cultural products have played in the construction of public opinion towards the condition itself and those who suffer it this ground breaking volume focuses on a variety of narratives as well as strategies of coping with hiv aids that have emerged across the globe bringing together research on the uk north and south america africa and china it provides rich textual analyses of the ways in which the hiv positive body has been portrayed in contemporary culture with attention to the differences between specific national contexts whilst keeping in view a space of commonality amongst the different experiences reflected in such texts as such it will be of interest to social scientists and scholars of cultural and media studies concerned with cultural production and representations of the body and sickness

this book on neuroaids a collection of chapters written by experts and specialists from around the world provides a global perspective on hiv and neuroaids in the field clinic and laboratory the chapters address the comorbidity of hiv and other infectious agents including zika virus ebola chagas disease tb and hcv also discussed are key topics such as molecular socioepidemiology global hiv and neuroaids neuropathology cart and blood brain barrier penetration hiv replicative oscillations hiv and siv evolution psychiatric comorbidities neurosyphilis the examination of current and innovative models of translational research to translational effectiveness
