in this second edition of their classic volume the authors present their elder abuse diagnosis and intervention model this comprehensive model of detection assessment and intervention enables the practitioner first to identify the type of elder mistreatment including physical sexual psychological and financial it then provides systematic and realistic interventions this updated edition also includes information on

legal interventions with suggestions on how the practitioner should act in the courtroom give testimony document findings and prepare for legal involvement with the criminal justice system actual legal tools are included in the appendix this is a classic resource for all health professionals who work with the elderly

first published in 1999 research on elder abuse in the united states has made great strides in recent years as a result we have been able to define and discover the causes of elder abuse design tools to assess the risk of abuse develop and implement treatment and prevention strategies and evaluate programs for victims and perpetrators however this research has been derived from studies whose subjects were primarily caucasian this is not because elder abuse does not take place in minority communities but rather because researchers wanted first to study the issue in its broadest sense

elder abuse has been increasingly recognised over the past ten years in many countries and progress has been made in both understanding and addressing the issue this volume provides a much needed international overview of the topic opening with an examination of what elder abuse is amanda phelan sets it in a theoretical context and looks at assessment and approaches to the issue in residential and community care environments the book then presents a range of country studies which provide an overview of the context of elder abuse in the country and a discussion of related policy legislation research and practice countries covered include ireland united kingdom spain china australia kenya israel canada and the united states whilst a regional chapter looks at south america a concluding chapter draws together cross cultural comparisons and provides some guidance as to best practice the only comprehensive book in this area international perspectives on elder abuse is an invaluable reference for practitioners academics and researchers from a range of disciplines including nursing social work sociology public health and social policy

order to make the tables and figures more interactive with readers third various sections have been added in different chapters fourth chapters 2 7 now include box inserts which include brief overviews written by professionals who are discussing some aspect of elder abuse finally chapter 7 has been added this new edition will help shed some light on what can be done to prevent elderly persons from being victimized or at least minimize the consequences of victimization when abuse does occur it will be of interest to those in several different disciplines including criminology gerontology social work social welfare sociology psychology victimology medicine and other social sciences

the abuse neglect and exploitation of older people in community and residential care settings is increasingly being recognised and addressed as a serious social concern in Britain and Canada elder abuse work gives an overview of the developments and issues in both countries and draws out good practice guidelines
