substantial philosophical problems chakrabarti demonstrates the advantage of doing philosophy in a cosmopolitan fashion beginning with an analysis of the concept of a thing and ending with an analysis of the concept of nothing realism interlinked offers a preview of a future metaphysics epistemology and philosophy of mind without borders
