this book endeavors to fill the conceptual gap in theorizing about embodied cognition the theories of mind and cognition which one could generally call situated or embodied cognition have gained much attention in the recent decades however it has been mostly phenomenology

heidegger merleau ponty etc which has served as a philosophical background for their research program the main goal of this book is to bring the philosophy of classical american pragmatism firmly into play although pragmatism has been arguably the first intellectual current which systematically built its theories of knowledge mind and valuation upon the model of a bodily interaction between an organism and its environment as the editors and authors argue it has not been given sufficient attention in the debate and consequently its conceptual resources for enriching the embodied mind project are far from being exhausted in this book the authors propose concrete subject areas in which the philosophy of pragmatism can be of help when dealing with particular problems the philosophy of the embodied mind nowadays faces a prominent example being the inevitable tension between bodily situatedness and the potential universality of symbolic meaning
